Matt Sumstine - Hawai'i High School Athletic Association (HHSAA) Coordinator of Officials and Division I, College Football Official (Mountain West Conference) -

Matt has been involved in officiating since 1991 and has extensive experience in judging and officiating from youth to Division I football. He has been a referee not only in youth football but has officiated Arena 2 Football beside his Division I college experience. Matt is a referee's referee. He was the 1st Replay official in the WAC, a Hula Bowl Field Official, refereed in the Sun Bowl, Emerald Bowl, Chick-fil-A Bowl, and the Armed Forces Bowl. Matt has been awarded a NFHS Football Official of the Year for Hawaii. He will discuss the union movement at Northwestern University, it's impact, the new NCAA ruling for the football training table and concussions. Matt is the owner of Mattl and Real Estate Services and has been a real estate professional since 1989 and lives with his wife and family in Makakilo. Matt will entertain questions from the luncheon guests.

Sharon Legacy - Vice President of the United States of America Gateball Association

- Gateball is played by over 10 million Gateball participants in 45 countries. The game is a variation of Croquet but it is more challenging. Gateball is played 3 times a week in Ala Moana Beach Park and all the equipment is provided by the association. The association hosts Gateball teams from various countries around the world and will participate in the World Tournament in Niigata City, Japan in September this year. Sharon first came to Hawai'i in 1988 and like the people, the customs and decided to move here. In 2004, she saw and experienced her first Gateball game. She joined the team and later became the President of the Hawai'i Gateball Association. Sharon will talk about the game, explain how it is played, discuss

the strategies of the game (she says it's like chess on grass) on Monday at the Honolulu Quarterback Club. Sharon will be open to take questions.
