Marilyn Moniz-Kaho'ohanohano – Associate Athletics Director – Senior Woman Administrator – University of Hawai'i – Retired – Marilyn returns after her retirement announcement of June 1st to give the HQB Club her last annual report on the Athletics Department. Her career of 28 years covered responsibilities for overseeing women's volleyball, soccer, water polo, cheerleading, men's and women's golf, men and women's tennis, sailing, men's and women's swimming and diving, plus the newly created NCAA sport, sand volleyball. At the same time, Marilyn monitored gender equity and NCAA compliance within the department. One of her major priorities was to make sure the athletics department is in compliance with the Patsy T. Mink Act (Title IX). Marilyn also strived to help reach the department's goal of financial stability while making improvements in student services. She worked closely with the academic unit to create and supervise academic services for student-athletes, while enhancing students' life skills and compliance.

Charlinda Ioane – Master's Candidate – Track & Field (Throws) – University of Hawai'i – Charlinda has been a track & field star since high school at Kapolei and during 2016 while attending UH has continued to excel in both discus and shot put qualifying for the NCAA Division I West Preliminary Round in both events finishing 28th in the discus throw preliminaries, and finished 48th in the shotput preliminaries. Here are some additional outdoor season highlights from 2016: She won bronze in the discus throw at the Big West Outdoor Championships and finished 7th in the shotput event, set a personal record of 49-9.75 in the shot put at the Beach Pacific Coast Event and won a silver medal. She now holds the team's 2nd best mark for this season in the disc throw from the Big West Championships and is ranked 4th on the University's outdoor all-time top 10 list for the shot put and 5th for the discus throw.

The Maple Garden Restaurant is located at 909 Isenberg (near the corner of King and Isenberg directly across from the Old Stadium Park) and there is free parking next to the Restaurant or street parking is available. The entrance to the meeting room is located at the rear of the Maple Garden building through the parking lot. Lunch is at 11:30 am and the program begins at 12 noon. The luncheon cost is \$16.00 per person for members and guests which include tax and gratuities. The food is fabulous!
